Cabernet Sauvignon grapes from Seven Hills Vineyard in Walla Walla, WA were fermented with some whole clusters in an effort to balance the naturally lush Walla Walla fruit with a more restrained, elegant structure. The wine was aged for 11 months in 100% French oak, one new, some once-filled and some neutral.

I recommend decanting this wine if you plan to drink it now. It has lovely fruit, but it's very young and decanting will allow it to open up. The wine should cellar well for at least ten years.
