The 2019 Dundee Hills Pinot Noir comes from two barrels of Pommard clone Pinot Noir from Balanza Vineyard in the Dundee Hills, one of the oldest AVAs in Oregon.

Pommard is a particularly elegant clone of Pinot Noir and tends to be later ripening offering bright red fruit flavors, and balanced acidity. Grown in the iron-rich Jory soils of the Dundee Hills, it shows rose/floral aromas and minerality. Fermentation with native (wild) yeasts produced a wine with a supple mouthfeel that fully expresses its terroir.

This wine is bright and elegant and will be great with salmon, chicken and wild mushrooms.

Drink now or cellar for 8 to 10 Years.
