The 2021 Willamette Valley Pinot Noir is a blend of fruit from several Willamette Valley Vineyards. The wine has plush red and dark berry fruit flavors paired with a soft, elegant texture and earthy, floral aromas. It will pair well with chicken, pork or salmon. Drink now or cellar for five or more years.

Clones: 777 (36%), 115 (36%), POM (11%), Wadenswil (12%), 113 (5%)

AVAs: Yamhill-Carlton (56%), Dundee Hills (18%), Ribbon Ridge (13%), Chehalem Mtn (13%)

Aged in 100% French oak for 11 months. Mostly neutral wine some new and some once and twice-filled barrels.
