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The 2022 Willamette Valley Pinot Noir is a blend of fruit from several Willamette Valley vineyards. The wine has plush red and dark berry fruit flavors paired with a soft, elegant texture and earthy, floral aromas. It will pair well with chicken, pork or salmon. Drink now or cellar for up to ten years.

AVAs: Yamhill (45%), Dundee Hills (20%), Eola-Amity Hills (19%), Ribbon Ridge (11%), Chehalem Mountain (5%)

Clones: 777 (45%), Pommard (37%), Wadenswil (9%), 115 (6%), 113 (3%)

The wine was fermented in small lots with native yeasts and about 30% whole clustered. It was aged for 11 months in french oak, using mostly neutral oak barrels, with about 20% new and once-used barrels.
